

Safety and Risk Management

1. All on-ice Coaches, Trainers, Assistant Coach, Assistant Trainer or Volunteers will be required to wear C.S.A. approved helmets during all on-ice activities. Sanctions for non-compliance: First incident results in written notification/warning by one or all of the following; MHL Board of Director, MHL Area Association Executive Member, MHL Office. On a second incident by the same party, that individual shall be suspended from participation in MHL activity for a minimum of 2 weeks. For the third infraction of the policy, the participant shall be suspended for a period of 1 year.
2. A player with a physical disability e.g. hearing, vision, etc. shall at the time of registration on a GTHL house league certificate or roster, or CHA certificate provide a certificate from a medical doctor which states that the subject player may safely engage in the level of hockey for which the player is being registered.
